# "Who Wore What When" Fashion Show Brought Many Generations Together

Brainchild of Aleasa Hogate, Education Director of the New Sweden Centre and recipient of the FASDV 2016 Citation of Recognition, "Who Wore What When" fashion show exhibited typical costumes in the Delaware Valley from 1638 until the early 1900's worn by Native Americans, Swedes, Finns and the Dutch from all walks of life, hunters to priests, soldiers to farmers. The afternoon included sampling of period foods, such as maize and berry bannock, piscataway berry pudding and tockwogh herbal tea.
